Waiver and Permission to Transport Child/Charge

I _____ give permission for my child/charge ("child") to participate in the Youth Summer Camp. I also give permission for my child to be transported in a motor vehicle driven by the Staff of The Alcohol & Drug Awareness Center for the Concho Valley (ADACCV) and its agents (Concho Valley CARES and YOUth CARES Staff and volunteers) to events and locations specified. I understand that my child is expected to follow all applicable laws regarding riding in a motor vehicle and is expected to follow the directions provided by the driver and/or other adult volunteers.

I have read, understand, and discussed with my child that:

- (1) They will be traveling in a motor vehicle driven by an adult and they are to wear their safety-belt while traveling;
- (2) They are expected to respect each other, the vehicles they ride in, and the people they travel with during the trip;
- (3) Riding in a motor vehicle may result in personal injuries or death from wrecks, collisions or acts by riders, other drivers, or objects; and
- (4) They are to remain in their seats and not be disruptive to the driver of the vehicle.

I grant permission for my child to participate in this activity, despite the possible risks. As a condition for the transportation received, I, for myself, my child, my executors and assigns, further agree to release and forever discharge ADACCV and their agents, officers, employees and volunteers from any claim that I might have myself or that I could bring on my child's behalf with regard to any damages, demands or actions whatsoever, including those based on negligence, in any manner arising out of this transportation. I have read this entire waiver and permission form, fully understand it, and agree to be legally bound by its terms.

Why Leadership Camp?

Positive Leaders in the school setting are positive INFLUENCERS to everyone. These leaders help to promote positivity in their school by what they do, and what they *don't* do. We want to train our youth to be leaders so that they maintain safe and healthy relationships, seek out people and experiences that are productive to achieving their personal goals and to say “no” to temptations that are unhealthy and unsafe. Understanding that the Middle School transition is an especially important time, ADACCV has developed the Summer Leadership Camp to help cultivate these young influencers.

The goal of this camp is to help youth by learning:

- How to manage stress
- How to maintain positive relationships
- How to be a good friend, even when it's hard
- How to say no to drugs, alcohol and other negative influences
- How to be a leader in their school to help make it a better place

Planned Speakers:

- Multiple leaders within our community will speak with the students about the qualities they need in order to be a leader amongst their peers.
- ADACCV Staff will facilitate activities that teach leadership and provide presentations that demonstrate the positive consequences of healthy choices.

Activities

- Students also participate in fun activities throughout camp. In past camps we have taken students to the Ropes Course, to volunteer at the Food Bank and Meals for the elderly, to tour the Donkey Rescue Facility and much more.

Additional Information
